Destination: Philippine Islands of Talikud, Samal & Mindanao

Project Emphasis: prayer walking, pulpit preaching, community crusades, servant evangelism & congregational care.

1. 1. April 1996, Mexico City, Mexico - work with inner city orphanage Ministerios De Amor and local SBC church and Pastor Ruben Berra.
2. 2. February 1997, Utuado, Puerto Rico - work with local SBC church and Pastor Tomas Morelos Montalvo.
3. March 1998, Shiprock, New Mexico - work with Local SBC church and Pastor Springwater.
4. January 5 - 16, 1999, Seven Men, Philippine Mindanao Island, Regions of Butwan & Augusan del Sur – reach Filipinos for Christ, encourage pastors & strengthen churches.
5. July 2000, Sydney, Australia – work with International Mission Board and International Sports Federation to prepare gospel outreach during 2000 Olympics.
6. July 17 - 29, 2000, Ten Men, Philippine Mindanao Island, Region of Davao City; Samal Island – reach Filipinos for Christ, encourage pastors & strengthen churches.
7. July 2001, Valencia, Venezuela – work with International Mission Board and M-Fuge to share gospel message, plant new works and encourage local churches primarily among reached peoples.
8. May 8 - 30, 2001, Seven Men, Philippine Mindanao & Samal Islands – reach Filipinos for Christ, encourage pastors & strengthen churches.

9. July 2002, Berlin, Germany – work with International Mission Board and World Changers to share gospel message, plant new works and encourage believers primarily among unreached peoples.

10. June 2003, Troy, Alabama – work with Pathfinders Ministries to share gospel message and encourage local believers.

11. July 2004, Samal/Talikud Island, Philippines – work along side Indigenous Pastors and congregations to share gospel message, encourage local fellowships and plant new works among unreached peoples.

12. July 2005, Samal/Talikud Island, Philippines -
TEAM # 1: work along side Indigenous Pastors on Talikud Island to evangelize and begin a new church plant in Santa Cruz;
TEAM # 2: work along side Indigenous Pastors and congregations on Samal Island to share gospel message, encourage local fellowships and raise up additional new works among unreached peoples.

13. July 2006, Mexico City/Cuernavaca Mexico– work along side the Conrad Family whom serve under the guidance of World indigenous Missions. We labored primarily through prayer walking, community service, street/park evangelism and a major construction project for local church with Pastor Blabino Diaz.

14. July 2007, Delhi, India – work along side the Mull Family whom serve under the guidance of The International Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention. We labored primarily through prayer walking, school visitation, street evangelism and “bridge building” support of an emerging church.

15. July 2008, New Orleans, Louisiana – work along side the Celebration Church of Metairie, LA. and Habitat for Humanity. We labored through a four-pronged approach: new home construction in 9th Ward, street evangelism in the French Quarter, Homeless Shelter outreach and evening evangelism/worship at the downtown Faith Mission.

16. July, 2009, Utuado, Puerto Rico - work with local SBC church and Pastor Tomas Morelos Montalvo.

17. July, 2010, New York City, NY. – worked alongside Street Life Ministries of Queens, NY. Joined God in sharing His Gospel in each of the six NYC Boroughs through prayer stations, tract distribution, Homeless Shelter visitation and children’s community park programs. Performed prayer drives, street worship, feeding stations and clothing/hygiene outreach.
